



# Gymkhana

We're going to take a break from our normal format!  
Our Mid-Summer Gymkhana will have more pairs events, and some added twists to test your horsemanship skills. Join us at **Color Run** on Sunday,  
**July 25, 2010** Starting at 10:00 AM

- Events: Figure 8 Flag Race  
Relay Race - Open Pairs Event  
Tie the Knot - Open Pairs Event  
Pole Bending (PeeWee riders will run Stakes - 5 poles, no run out)  
Bend and Hurdle (Jump poles will be laid on the ground for PeeWee riders - step over vs. jump)  
Ribbon Race - Open Pairs Event  
Twister - Jackpot event\*  
Flag and Back - Open Event run for fun only - Ribbons awarded but no Championship points
- Classes: PeeWee - 10 or under  
Youth - 11 through 17  
Adult - 18 and over  
Senior - 40 and over (See Rules on Page 2 for Adult/Senior eligibility)
- Entry Fees: \$18 for the day for Youth, Adult, or Senior Riders. \$10 for PeeWee riders
- Awards: We will award First through Sixth place Ribbons for each event, as well as Champion and Reserve Champion Rosettes for each class. We will also have a High Point Award which will be awarded to the entrant with the most points for the day, regardless of class, and including the pairs event.
- Location: The corner of Barton Road and Master Street (Rens. County Route 114) in Johnsonville. Entrance for parking is immediately past the barn after turning onto Barton Road from Route 114.

\* We will run a 50/50 drawing during the show. A drawing will be held for a winner of 50% of the amount collected by ticket sales. The remaining 50% will be used as payout for the Jackpot event. There is no additional entry fee for the Jackpot.
